LAND USE ZONING 

If you are going to build a fence, build a building, remove a building, add a building, add on to your home or existing structure, remove cement, add cement you are required to fill out a Land Use Application.

- *Land Use Zoning Permits are good for one year upon approval.*
- *Cost is \$5.00*
- *Submit your project to the city at least two months in advance in case you will need a public hearing, which requires public notice in a local newspaper and area neighbors within 350', per MN State Statute 462.357 and City Code #10.*
- *You do not need a permit for replacing a roof, window, or door.*
- *Land Use Application is on the City Webpage or can be picked up at the City Hall.*
